History Autodesk began developing its first CAD system, DECwriter, in 1978. During that time, the company grew, attracting venture capital. By 1982, the company was exploring ways to enter the computer-aided design market with a lower-cost product than DECwriter. The company's CEO, John Warnock, recognized that this would require the development of an internal graphics engine for which he would become responsible. Warnock explained that Autodesk's mainframes, such as the PDP-11/23 or PDP-11/40, provided a way to create and develop its first CAD system. The mainframe was at that time being replaced by personal computers which offered many advantages, including the ability to store a large design library. The first version of Autodesk's CAD system, AutoCAD, was designed for Apple II computers with an internal graphics chipset. It was released in December 1982 to much success. The first release of AutoCAD included basic 2D drafting and design features, while lacking 3D, feature-based modeling, and some important 2D drafting functions. Two years later, AutoCAD was completely redesigned to be modular and feature-based. This early version of AutoCAD, released in June 1984, introduced additional 2D features and laid a foundation for AutoCAD's future. In 1986, Autodesk released AutoCAD LT, which was much cheaper than AutoCAD and targeted toward the emerging desktop computer market. Autodesk also launched the first affordable graphics-to-image (GIMP) tools for home users. In 1990, the same year that Autodesk acquired digital photographic services provider Alias, the company changed its name to Autodesk. In 1998, Autodesk bought Alias and added new 2D and 3D features. In 1999, Autodesk released AutoCAD 2000, which added DWG (design, web, and international) support, the ability to import and export 3D models, and a feature-based interface that resembled AutoCAD's user interface. The same year, Autodesk launched Project MAYA, a mid-range product for architecture and engineering. In 2005, Autodesk released AutoCAD 2005, the first release to include the A360 Architecture Platform (a toolset and web services) for producing 3D models. In 2009, Autodesk acquired Arup, a UK-based engineering design and consultancy company
